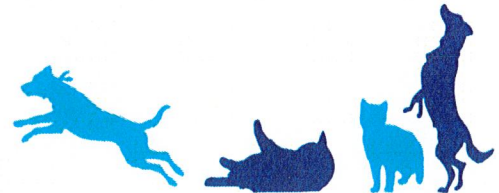
I am a old brown and green, Intact Male!

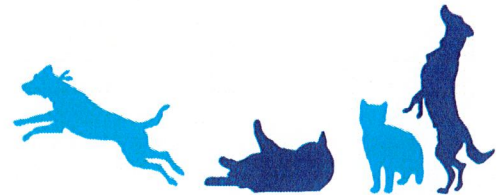

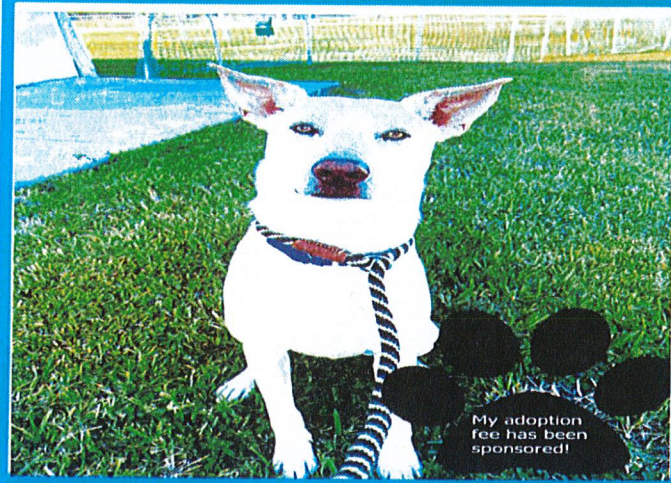

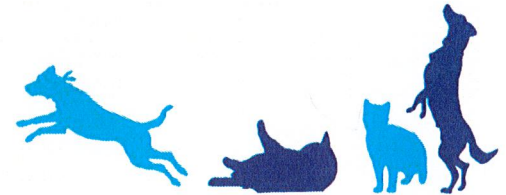
I am a 1 year 2 month old cream, neutered male!
